

Pine Lake Township Board Meeting

June 3rd, 2021

- Meeting called to order, members present: Bob, Ken and Tim

- **Committee Reports:**
 - May Minutes were read by Ken, Bob made a motion to approve and Tim seconded the motion. Motion carried.
 - Treasurer's report was read, Bob made a motion to approve and Tim seconded the motion. Motion carried.

- **Old Business:**
 - Kurt discussed Pine Mountain Road, was not able to meet at the site. Will get together with Bob on site and review the issues and repairs.
 - 490th needs major repairs. Bob Sieling has talked to Bob Schielman at Apex about 490th Street. Will meet with Curt O. to review the issues and repairs needed. Will repair with 6 inches of class 5 and a 3.5 inch asphalt patch.
 - Discussed culvert on 460th. Curt O. will meet with board on site for inspection.
 - Calcium Chloride will be applied to 450th and 410th this year. Specific roads will be inspected and calcium chloride will be applied to specific roads on an annual basis.

- **New Business:**
 - The river road (460th) needs signage. It was decided that in addition to updating the signage Curt O. would build up the low side of the curve in order to prevent continued driving in the ditch. Curt will pick up the required signs.
 - Mowing ditches will be reviewed in July.
 - 428th needs brushing out on the north side of the road. Action on this was tabled until the July meeting.
 - John Guck and Cordell Huebsch presented a plat of a new development on the northwest corner of the township on land formerly owned by the Theodorson family. They were seeking township approval of a road that would not meet the required 66" roadway width. After much discussion the board agreed not to accept any road that did not meet township (county) standards including a 66' road width.
 - Bob Sieling brought up the available American Rescue Plan (ARP) funds. MAT will be coming out with more detailed information on what these funds can be used for and how to apply for them. Action was tabled pending review of the MAT information.
 - **Township Bills;** Bob made a motion to pay all bills presented and Tim seconded the motion. Motion carried.
