• Committee Reports:

- The township has decided to keep the road open by VonRudens; the board feels it is important to keep the road open for emergencys. The approach can be barricaded but not the township road.

- The board will not pay Ottertail County for stripping until they can review the contract.
- > Jeff Stabenow prepared road construction standards for the township covering roads, approaches and culverts. The standards were reviewed by the board. Bob made a motion to approve the standards; Tim seconded the motion. Motion carried.
- The board wants the Annual Newsletter sent out in February.
- Tim made a motion to pay all bills, Bob seconded the motion. Motion carried.
