• Committee Reports:

- October Minutes were read, Tim made a motion to approve and Bob seconded the motion. Motion carried.

A 10% retainer will be withheld until next November and a few issues are addressed and the road remains stable. The Board will review the shoulders next year and the degree of slope.
- Bob reported that he walked the gravel pit land owned by the township, he also talked to Jerome and asked that his son-in-law talk to the Bickerstaff's and work out an agreement on hunting the pit and where the stands are at. Bob will check back later with Jerome on resolution of these issues.

New Business:

- Keith Friesen trapped beavers and Kurt will go back out and knock the beaver hut down.
- > On Wavy Road Wayne filled the hole with class 5.
- The Board received the annual form from the County for 2019 sand sealing and the application of fog lines. The Board will discuss sand sealing in on 428th Street,490th Avenue and Minnesota Street. Fog line on 445th only. Tim made a resolution to accept those and Bob seconded. Resolution passed.
- Tim forewarned Wayne that he needs to keep the roads cleaned off and well sanded. Especially the roads that had issues last year.
