# Pine Lake Township Board Meeting

### November 3rd, 2021

• Meeting called to order, members present Tim, Bob, Ken, and Sue

### • Committee Reports:

- October Minutes were read, Bob made a motion to approve, and Tim seconded the motion. Motion carried.
- Treasurer's report was read, Bob made a motion to approve, and Tim seconded the motion. Motion carried.

## • Old Business:

- The board discussed building of a new township hall or adding onto the existing hall using funds ARPA and Township funds. Bob made a motion to have Kurt work on a building proposal. Board agreed to \$60 per hour not to exceed \$1,000; Tim seconded the motion. The board wants to have some figures and tentative plans ready to present at the March Annual Meeting.

The amount of heavy equipment has caused the township road to breakup where the driveways meet the tar road. Curt has suggested repairing with asphalt patch this year and see if that holds up.

### New Business:

- > The board has asked Kurt and Curt to blade all roads one more time this fall.
- > Ronald Manchester submitted a new approach application and deposit.
- Curt asked the board to look at 440<sup>th</sup> where it meets Mosquito Heights Road. People are driving on the shoulders; should be widened out there. Curt Also reported that the curve on 460<sup>th</sup> has potholes that he will try to repair.
- Kurt reported that due to a county project trucks are hauling materials on Cranberry Drive, 410<sup>th</sup>, Minnesota Street and 510<sup>th</sup>. The additional traffic and weight has necessitated additional blading on these roads. Kurt estimates he has 12 additional hours so far. Bob will call the County to request reimbursement.
- Barb Gilber texted Tim about 460<sup>th</sup>. Complained that it is constantly wash boarding. Will look at hauling clay in next year. This is a shared road with Perham Township so will advise Perham and recommend a joint project.
- Township Bills: Tim made a motion to pay all bills presented and Bob seconded the motion. Motion carried.
