Committee Report:

- > Sue read the April Board Minutes; Bob made a motion to approve ad Tim seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Old Business:

- ➤ 490th Repairs; Perham Sand and gravel recommeds to cut down 4 to 5" and add gravel. Rebuild the height of the shoulders one mile to the T a minimum of 2 feet. All cracks will be sealed.
