

May 4th Township Meeting

Committee Report:

- Sue read the April Board Minutes; Bob made a motion to approve and Tim seconded the motion. Motion carried.
- Ken read the Treasurer's report, Bob made a motion to approve and Tim seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Old Business:

- **490th Repairs**; Perham Sand and gravel recommends to cut down 4 to 5" and add gravel. Rebuild the height of the shoulders one mile to the T a minimum of 2 feet. All cracks will be sealed. The total estimate is \$2,692.00, not to exceed \$33.70 a yard. Bob made a motion to approve and Tim seconded the motion. Motion carried.
- **53rd and 137th**; RMS estimates project will need 6 to 7,000 yards. Estimate includes blading, haulin and class 5. Quote is \$10.42 a yard. Curt stated he could start in 2 1/2 to 3 weeks. Bob made a motion to approve and Tim seconded the motion. Motion carried.
- **Joint Project 400th**; Otto Township has stated they will pull the shoulders down; Wayne will check to see if that is completed. Wayne will quote the blading and gravel. Further discussion is tabled until the June meeting.

New Business:

- The Township will consider spraying 445th. Discussion on ditch spraying is tabled until the June meeting.
- **Mike Kaminski** is requesting a speed study on 460th. Mike is requesting a 20 mile per hour speed limit. Bob stated that the township cannot arbitrarily assign speed limits. A speed study must be done by the DOT and at this time there is no basis to request a speed study, statute 169.14. Alteration shall be made only upon the authority of the commissioner.
- **Dale Lubitz** requested that the township consider crack filling and shoulder widening on Minnesota Street. Bob will inspect the road and get some estimates started.
- **440th**; Bob will also look at 440th and 460th and Mosquito Heights Road for seal coating. Tim made a motion to proceed to obtain bids, Bob seconded the motion. Motion carried.
- Curt will spray the road ditches that were not sprayed last year.
- Bob attended a Rinke Nonan seminar on Roads, Right-of-Ways, Easements, Cart-ways and Wetlands.
- **Adjournment**; Bob made a motion to adjourn, Tim seconded the motion. Motion carried.
