Paving Projects

- 445th; Jeff Stabnow reported that there is a trouble area on the new 445th paving project. Board asked why the shoulders are not at 1 foot on the entire project. Jeff explained that the project was bid on tonnage and not on specs; the one-foot shoulder was implemented as much as possible. The township has decided to leave the speed limit unposted for now. The law then follows to drive at reasonable & prudent speeds up to 55 mph.
